Safe Handling: Avoid ingestion. Standard cosmetic handling practices apply. Always dilute before skin application for best results, although lavender is one of the few essential oils sometimes used neat in small quantities.

Storage Requirements: Store in an area that is cool, dry, and well-ventilated. Do not expose to temperatures over 30°C. Keep away from light to preserve the delicate aroma.
